In Retail Commerce we are aware of the importance of Internet Privacy and the need to adopt information and consent formulas that meet the transparency and control requirements expected by our customers and users. Therefore, and complying with the obligations provided in the second section of article 22 of Law 34/2002, of July 11, on services of the information society and e-commerce, after its modification by Royal Decree Law 13 / 2012, from March 30 (hereinafter, LSSI) we offer you this Cookies Policy.

What are cookies?

Cookies are files or devices that are downloaded to the user's terminal equipment that visits the website in order to store and retrieve data found on the said device. The main objective of these files is to collect information mainly from browsers, which is useful for the continuous improvement of the services we offer.

Cookies do not usually store sensitive information of any kind such as credit cards or bank details, photographs or personal information, etc. The data they save is technical, statistical, browsing preferences, etc.

The information is not associated with your person but with the web browser used from the device with which you connect.

What kind of cookies exist?

- Technical cookies: they are the most basic and allow, among other things, to know when a human or an automated application is browsing, when an anonymous and registered user navigates, basic tasks for the operation of any dynamic website.
- Analysis cookies: they collect information about the type of navigation, the sections you use most, products consulted, time zone of use, language, etc.
- Advertising cookies: show advertising based on navigation, country of origin, language, etc.

What are own and third-party cookies?

Own cookies are those generated by the page you are visiting and those of third parties are those generated by external services or providers such as Facebook, Twitter, GoogleAds or Doppler.
